
The tool Profile of Fleet Electrification, also called EV Overview, is a dashboard that makes it possible to see data on the vehicles on the road in Québec for each engine type, whether electric or others.

The tool features 2 dashboards: the history since 2017 and the current overview.

THIS TOOL ACHIEVES 3 OBJECTIVES :

1. Allows stakeholders in our ecosystem and decision-makers to be aware of the state of progress of vehicle electrification in Quebec;
2. Allows vehicle manufacturers from here and elsewhere to assess the potential market of EV development in Quebec;
3. Responds to issues related to misconceptions of the profile of commercial and institutional fleets.

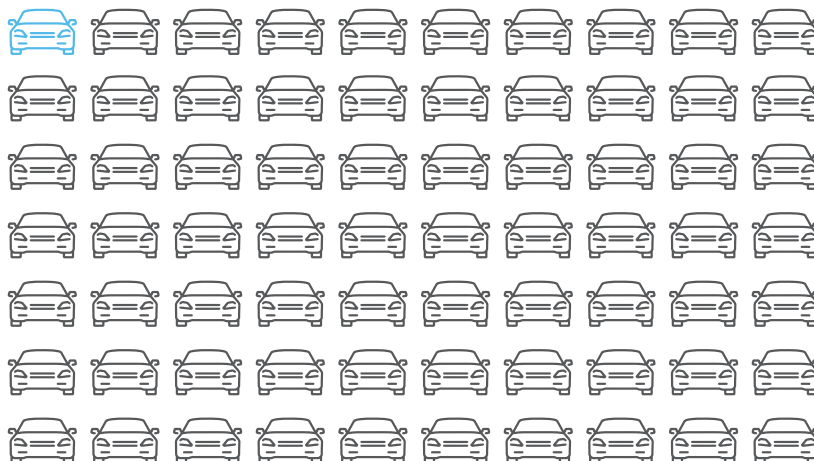

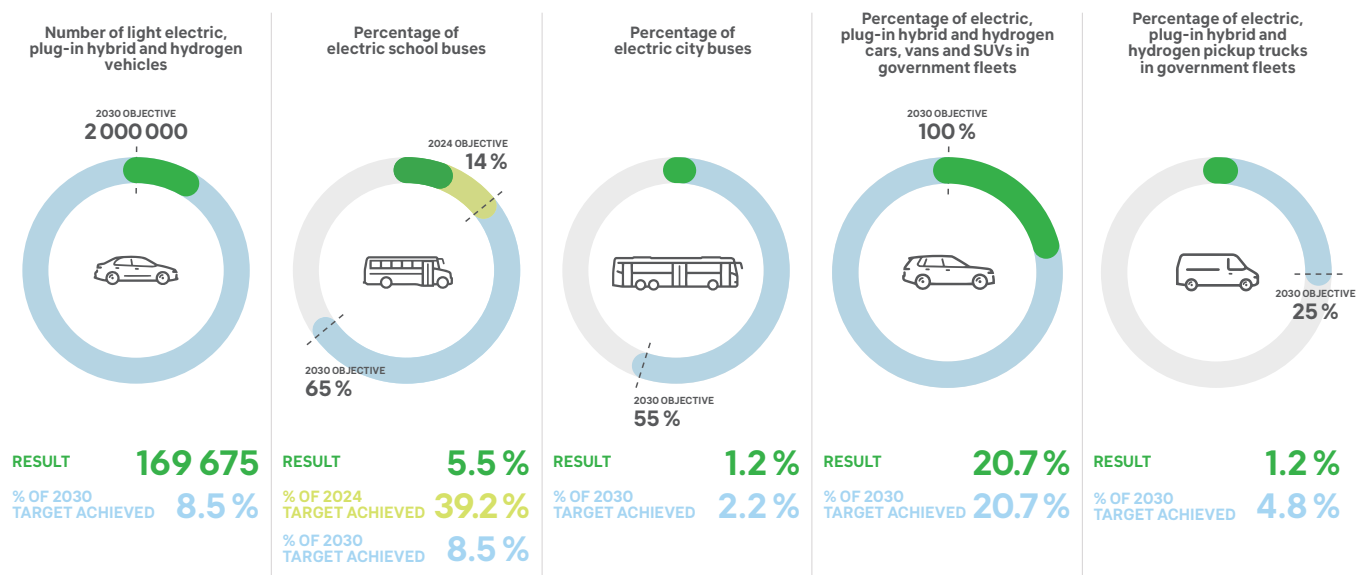

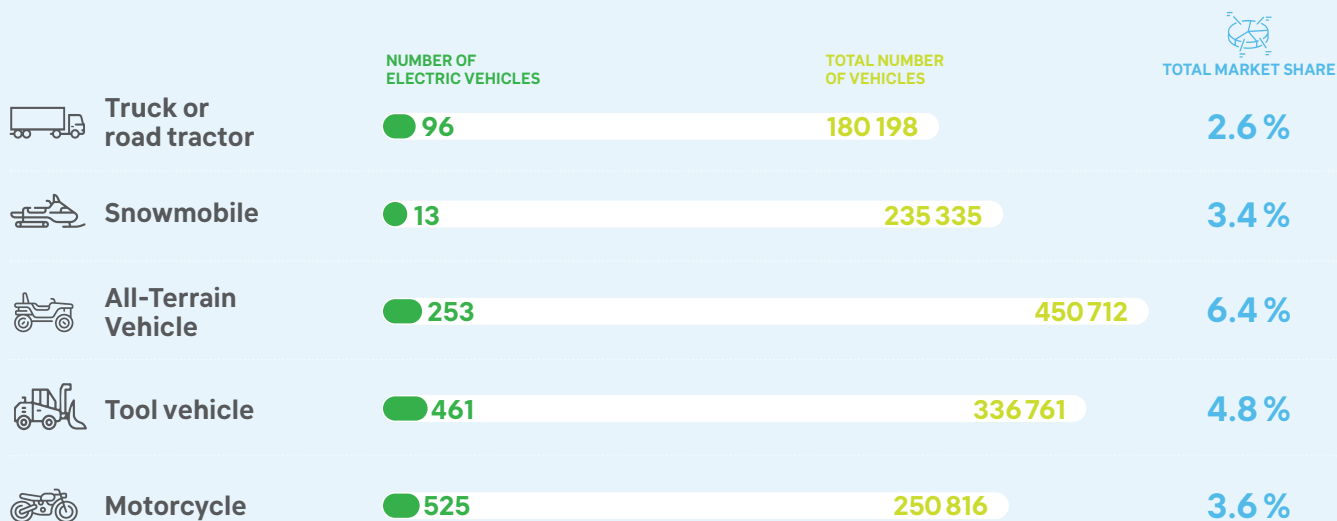
Provincial Government Objectives
